Remember that stage directions are in the PRESENT tense, in brackets.

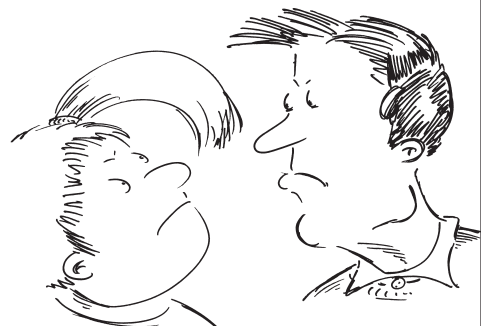
SCENE 6: THE LIVING ROOM AFTER SUNDAY LUNCH
