

WOLF

Abbreviations: K = knit. p = purl. s.s = stocking stitch (k. on the right side, p. on the wrong side), Inc. = increase by working twice into same stitch. k2tog. = k two stitches together

Skpo = slip one, knit one, pass slipped stitch over B&T = break off yarn and thread through remaining stitches on needle, pull together and fasten off

Instructions in round brackets. These are repeated the number of times stated after the closing brackets

Use grey double knitting wool and a pair needles size 3mm (No.11)

The body

Begin at lower edge of one leg - cast on 22 sts.

Inc. in each st. (knitwise) (44 sts)

S.s 9 rows

*k4, (k2tog) x 13, k14 (31 sts)

p. 1 row

k3, (K2og) x 8, k12 (23 sts)

**P. 1 row

k to last 12 sts. k1, (k2tog. k2,) x 2, k2tog. k1 (20 sts)

S.s 15 rows

k4, (k2,inc.1) x5, k1 (25 sts)

p.1 row

k5, (k4, inc1) x3, k5 (28 sts)

p 1 row

Increase 1 st. at both ends of the next 2 rows (32 sts)

ss. 10 rows

Break off and leave stitches on a spare needle

Work other leg in the same way but as far as *

Then k14, (k2tog) x13, k4

p. 1 row

k12, (k2tog) x8, k3

Then continue as other leg from **

Don't break off yarn but with right side of work facing k. across 32 sts. of left leg, then across those on the spare needle. (64 sts.)

Beginning with a p. row s.s 6 rows

k9, (k5,k2tog) x 7, k6 (57 sts)

p 1 row

k8, (k5, k2tog) x 7 (50sts)

Dec 1 st at both ends of next 4 rows. (42 sts)

(p5, p2tog) x6 (36sts)

s.s 15 rows

Dec 1 at both ends of next row (34 sts)

s.s 10 rows

Cast off.

Head

Cast on 34 sts

s.s 6 rows

Cast on 8 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows (50 sts)

Inc.1., k20, skpo, k4, k2tog. k20, inc.1

Inc. at beg. and end of next row. (52sts)

Shape mouth

k3 (k1, inc1) x4, k30 (inc1, k1) x4, k3 (60 sts.)

p 1 row

k 27, skpo, k2, k2tog., k27 (58 sts)

p. 1 row

Shape jaw

Cast on 3sts. then k. to end (61 sts)

cast on 3sts. then p. to end (64 sts)

k 1 row

p 1 row

k 1 row

p. 1 row

Decrease 11 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows (42 sts)

p. 1 row

Right side

k 13, incl. work on these 15 sts.

p 1 row

Dec 1 st at beg. and end of row

p.1 row

Dec 1 st at beg & end of row

p. 1 row

dec. at beg & end of next 2 rows (7sts.)

cast off

Work gusset

Rejoin wool on remaining 28 sts.

Inc. 1, k 12, inc 1

s.s 24 rows

dec 1 st at both ends of next 4 rows (8 sts)

s.s 6 rows

dec 1st at both ends of next row (6 sts)

ss 16 rows

dec at both ends of next row (4 sts)

p 1 row

k2 tog, k2tog

B&T

Left side

Inc 1. k 13, work on these 15 sts.

p 1 row

Dec 1 st at beg. and end of row

p 1 row

Dec 1 st at beg & end of row

p. 1 row

dec. at beg & end of next 2 rows (7 sts.)

cast off

Arms

Cast on 15

Inc. in each stitch (knitwise)

s.s 9 rows

k5, (k2tog.)x10, k5.

s.s 25 rows

(k3, inc in next st.) x 4, k4.

s.s 5 rows beg. with purl row

Cast off.

Tail

Cast on 14 sts.

s.s 14 rows

Dec. 1 st. at beginning of next 2 rows. (12 sts)

s.s 4 rows

Dec. 1 st. at beginning of next 2 rows. (10 sts)

s.s 4 rows

Dec. 1 st. at beginning of next 2 rows. (8 sts)
s.s 4 rows
K 4, K2tog. k.4 (7 sts)
s.s 3 rows
k.3, k2og. k.4 (6 sts)
p. 1 row
k. 2tog. to end
4 sts.b & t tightly

Ears

Cast on 6 sts.
Ss 4 rows
Inc. at both ends (8 sts.)
Ss 3 rows
Dec. at both ends (6 sts.)
p.1 row
Dec at both ends of next 2 rows (2sts.)
Cast off

Jumper (*Front and back - make 2 the same*)

Using yellow wool cast on 34 sts.
Work 6 rows in k2. p2. rib
Work the next 20 rows in s.s in alternating colours.
Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.
Then decrease 1 st. at each end of the next and every alternative row
until 20 stitches remain.
Join on yellow wool and work 4 rows in k1., p1, rib.
Cast off.

Sleeves - make 2 the same

In yellow - cast on 26 sts.
Work 4 rows in k1. p1. rib
Work 24 rows in s.s, in pattern matching jumper front
Dec 3 sts at both ends of next 2 rows (20 sts.)
Dec 1 st. at both ends of next 7 rows (6 sts)
Cast off.

To make up.

Oversew cast on stitches of feet. Join row ends of **legs** and back seam of **body** leaving a gap in the back. Turn right side out and stuff, pushing it down well into feet. Then stitch up back and continue to fill body up to neck level. Make up **head** by matching two sides pieces to edges of head with the gusset down the centre (helps if this is all pinned into place.), making sure gusset comes well over muzzle. Stitch and then stuff.

Stitch head to top of neck, adding extra stuffing if necessary to make a firm join.

Join row ends of **arm**, stuff, and sew onto body. Repeat for other arm.

Join row ends of **tail**, stuff sew in place.

Attach ears.

Oversew a **nose** with black wool.

Cut ovals in white felt for **eyes**, mark the centre with pen and glue to face.

Join to sides of jumper up to arm holes. Join up sleeves and then attach to jumper at arm holes. Join up yellow neck band.

Cut out 'Wolf decoration' from felt and attach to front of jumper.
